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A Farewell

After over 15 years and with some sadness, I will be retiring from Blueteq. It has been a period of change and challenges that both Blueteq and the NHS have had to face.



Having previously worked for large software developers providing systems for medium and large multinationals, it was a major change coming to Blueteq and working with the NHS. At the time Blueteq was a very small company working initially with a single PCT on the High Cost Drug & IFR systems and developing a system to support an independent provider. However, Graham Simmonds, one of the founding Directors had a vision and ambition to significantly grow our systems within the NHS.

I am grateful to Graham for his tutelage around the systems but even more so to colleagues at Surrey PCT who kindly helped me to develop an understanding of the issues and challenges that they faced and how the system could help and support them.

Armed with this knowledge and their support we started our mission to spread the word about the system and initially it did feel evangelical! I am forever grateful to those PCTs who also adopted the system and not only saw its potential benefits but also helped us to develop it further. They also supported us by enabling other PCTs, and later CCGs, to speak with them about why they adopted the system and what it was helping them to deliver. To all of you – thank you!

As you are aware, the systems are used in around 90% of commissioners in England including NHS England and more recently the High Cost Drug system was adopted in Wales, Jersey, and Guernsey.

Blueteq has also undergone significant changes in this period. From humble beginnings in a small, rented office at Stansted House where we had two people focussed on the development of those systems, we are now in our current building with just under 30 staff, all dedicated to supporting our clients. Our company has also gone through structural and ownership changes such that we are an Employee Owned Trust (EOT).

I have to say that I have loved my time at Blueteq. I have had the privilege of working with fantastic colleagues who work tirelessly to both support our clients and system but also embrace the task of adding changes to systems in response to requests from you, our clients. It is glib to say it but the attitude of my colleagues and culture of Blueteq is truly "tell us what you want, and we can do it".

Mostly, I would like to thank you all. While there have occasionally been bumps in the road and some challenges, I am grateful for your support and help during these times which was underpinned by your sense of fairness and often humour.

I wish you well with the challenges faced now but I am confident that, as ever, you will adapt and come through this. I am also confident that my colleagues will continue to do whatever they can to help and support you.

I have loved working with you and will miss you and thank you for all you have done over the years — it's been quite a ride!
